2025 William & Gladys Foley Scholarship

Each year, we provide college scholarships to the children of Big C employees to help fund their learning and set them up for success in their careers. We are proud to announce two things: we are increasing the scholarship amount from \$4,000 to \$6,000 per year, up to four consecutive years to account for rising costs in education, and we will also offer scholarships of \$3,000 per year for two year degrees including community college and qualified tech schools. Marshall Holycross Award - Jennifer Baker

Jennifer Baker (Inside Sales) started at the Kendallville location in 1996 when it was formally Broadview Lumber. "I worked there for eight years prior to Big C acquiring the business in 2004.
